

## Flemington & Kensington Wins the 2006 Tim McCoy Award.

The Trustees of the Tim McCoy Trust invited nominations for the 16<sup>th</sup> annual 'Tim McCoy Award'. The \$1000 Award celebrates the life of the late Tim McCoy (1956–1987). The award recognises the work of individuals, groups or organisations within the community law or legal aid movement. A particular but not exclusive focus is the promotion of human rights and justice for socially and economically disadvantaged people in Victoria. Nominations specifically addressed at least one of the following criteria:



- Outstanding achievement in human rights *advocacy* and justice for socially and economically disadvantaged people and communities in Victoria
- Achievement in undertaking a range of *law reform and/or community legal education* activities over an extended period, or a single significant law reform or community legal education initiative that protects and promotes human rights and justice for socially and economically disadvantaged people and communities in Victoria
- Outstanding *contribution above the call of duty* in protecting and promoting human rights and justice for people and communities in Victoria.
- The Trustees welcome nominations that reflect collaborative and network initiatives.
